## **Notice:** Net Reports 2021

Starting in the new calendar year, we will have a new procedure to sign up as a Net Control Operator.

- 1. Pick the date or dates when you would like to be the Net Control Station.

- 3. I will input your call-sign for the dates you choose in the Net Control Roster.
- 4. The monthly calendar will have your call-sign for the dates you choose. The full monthly roster will be published periodically in the Static.
