April 18th, 2023

The Treasures report was called for and given by the President who reported that we have a balance of \$5008.64 on deposit, a motion to accept the report as given was voted on and passed. A reading of the minutes of the last meeting was given by the secretary, one correction was noted (the date for the food drive is May 20th) and a motion to accept the minutes as read was made and a vote was taken and passed. The Member at large was asked if he had a report and he stated he had none at this time.

The President announced that "GEORGE ZIGORIS, W8ZIG" a long-time member of W8ACW has passed away at his home in New Mexico. A notice of his passing was asked to be put in the newsletter and club minutes so that those who knew him would be made aware of his becoming a Silent Key.

Old Business,

- 2. The Constitution committee was asked for a report on the status of the revisions, and they stated they're working on a time and place for a meeting.
- 3. The President reported that he's still waiting on a report of possible sites for Field Day, and that he has material in his garage for the event.
